### **\*\*All Pathways Matter\*\***

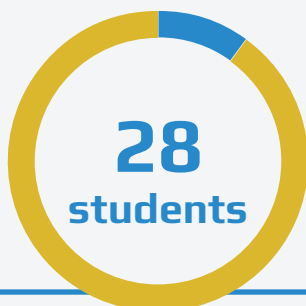

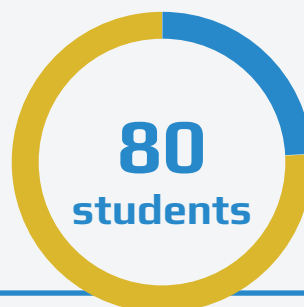
Core Mentoring Program

## 2024-2025 program year by the numbers

- 1,497 youth served
- 52 schools served across North and South Carolina
- 20 college tours
- Nine worksite visits
- Five trade school visits
- Seven cohorts hosted
- 10 students participated in job shadowing opportunities
- Seven new vocational/trade school partnerships created



# Senior Highlights



- Number of seniors: 40 seniors
- \$2.6M in scholarship dollars awarded to the Class of 2025
- 200+ college acceptances
- One vocational/trade school acceptances
- Average GPA of 3.59 from graduating seniors

# 2024-2025 Program Outcomes



- 100% of students increased their knowledge around college and career options
- 100% of students felt our program was a safe place
- 100% of seniors matriculated through high school successfully
- 100% of students felt that there was at least one adult in the program that they could talk to about life and school
- 100% increased their social skills
- 100% of students felt a sense of belonging and that their voice mattered
- 96% of students felt that they increased their life skills
